WHAT TO BRING

General Room Items

- 3M Command removable products
- Room decorations
- Laundry bag/basket
- Laundry detergent/dryer sheets
- Clothes hangers
- Desk chair
- A few dishes
- Surge protector and electrical strips
- Extension cord (shorter than 15 ft.)

Bed + Bath Items

- Pillow and pillowcases
- Blankets, comforter, and XL twin sheets
- Personal toiletries
- Shower caddy
- Hairdryer
- Towels and washcloths
- Wastebasket(s)
- Air freshner(s)

Academic Supplies

- Backpack
- USB flash drive
- Notebooks
- Pens
- Other office supplies

First Aid Items

- Pain reliever
- Band-aids
- Tissues
- Cold medication

Miscellaneous

- SS card, insurance card, passport and medical
- Batteries
- Bike (optional) and lock
- Technology items

Optional Items

- Computer: there are computers on campus that you can use, but if you choose to bring your own, you might also need an Ethernet cord, printer, ink, and copy paper
- Television: maximum of 27" standard or 32" flat panel with stand (not mounted)
- Small refrigerator: 4.0 cu. sq. ft. max per room; Either one 4.0 fridge or two 2.0 fridges per room are allowed

WHAT TO LEAVE AT HOME

- Subwoofers
- Surround Sound
- Large furniture
- Couches over 5ft. long
- Halogen lamps, octopus lamps, or space heaters
- Microwave, toaster oven, hot plate, or George Foreman Grill

- Weapons or fireworks of any kind (including airsoft or paintball guns)
- Candles and/or incense
- Bookshelves over 6ft. tall
- Pets of any kind (that means fish too)

WHAT IS PROVIDED

Bunk Bed

- Includes 2 drawers per bed

Nightstand

- 2 nightstands per room (3 drawers each)

Study Desk

- 2 desks per room (4 drawers with small shelf)

Closet

- 2 closets per room (shelf & ample hanging space)

Cleaning Supplies

- Common household cleaning supplies

Miscellaneous

- Vacuums, microwaves, and laundry facilities (included in each building)
